

SECTION IX
GUIDELINES FOR COURSE AND CURRICULUM CHANGES
ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS

Change and adaptation in both courses and curricula are to be expected with expanding knowledge and changes within the faculty and size of the University. Recognizing the need for change, the College of Education and Human Development and the University have adopted well-defined guidelines and procedures for changes in courses and curricula.

The University guidelines for the University Curriculum Council are found in Appendix A of this document. The Bylaws for the College of Education and Human Development Curriculum Committee and for the Council for Teacher Education are found in Appendix B of this document. Being cognizant that teacher education is a University-wide function and that changes affecting teacher education curricula may originate from both within and outside of the College of Education and Human Development, the University has a Council for Teacher Education which includes representatives of all academic areas of the University offering teacher education programs. The Dean of the College of Education appoints the Council for Teacher Education and serves as an ex-officio member. All academic actions affecting teacher education programs must be approved by the Council for Teacher Education and the Dean of the College of Education and Human Development. All curriculum changes approved by the Council for Teacher Education are subject to the approval of the Graduate Council (when necessary), the University Curriculum Council, and the President of the University.
