Concentration Electives must be selected from **FCS, PSYC, SOC, SW, HS, COMM, EDUC, NURS, SPED, ECE, EPSY, ETEC, or ANTH 101, ANTH 411, CJ 101, CJ 201, CJ 207, PHIL 310, PHIL 313, ENGL 322.**
