2. Social Sciences to be selected from: ANTH, POLI, ECON, GEOG, PSYC, SOC and one course must be 200-level or above.

+ A grade of "C" or better is required in these courses.

\* Twelve hours of Concentration Requirements must be in 300 or 400 level courses. Concentration Requirements must be selected from **FCS, PSYC, SOC, SW, HS, COMM, EDUC, NURS, SPED, LSED, ECE, EPSY, ETEC, OR ANTH 101, ANTH 411, CJ 101, CJ 201, CJ 207/PSYC 205, PHIL 310, PHIL 313, ENGL 322**. Students successfully completing the degree plan, including: COMM 378, HS 251, FCS 252 and FCS 442 within their Concentration Requirements, may be eligible to apply for Provisional status as a Certified Family Life Educator (CFLE) with the National Council on Family Relations (NCFR).
