1. Students with an ACT score of 20 or lower will take Math 155 (5 credit hours) in place of Math 161, which will increase 2 credit hours the total number of hours required for the degree.
2. Students may utilize electives for Child Welfare grant requirements.
3. Social Work, Sociology, Psychology, Political Science, Anthropology, Geography except 205, and Family and Consumer Science.
4. Students may not schedule SW 497 and SW 498 until completion of all curricula requirements and prior social work courses have been completed. They must also have a minimum adjusted grade point average of 2.5.
