Practicum for Technology Leadership

Master Syllabus

The Practicum in Technology Leadership is designed to provide practical experience for Technology Leadership students. It should be viewed as an opportunity for students to relate theories learned in the classroom to the actual practices of educational institutions.

The success of the practicum is dependent upon the cooperation of the parties involved—the University, the student, and the supervisor/administrator. The following delineates the responsibilities of each:

The University:

The University is responsible for structuring the course and has responsibility for the final evaluation of the students' experiences. It is also responsible for providing guidance and individual assistance to students enrolled in the practicum.

Supervisory Personnel:

Persons who supervise practicum students should provide opportunities for them to become involved in technology leadership activities that result in worthwhile learning experiences and monitor their progress in these activities.

Students:

1. Be responsible for their own learning
2. Complete the Practicum Agreement in cooperation with the University and the school supervisor.
3. Submit a weekly log of their activities and a report (paper) on their experiences.
4. Attend seminars as scheduled.
5. Spend the minimum number of hours for credit in the practicum in worthwhile activities.
6. Follow all the policies of the participating school system.
7. Be continuously involved in self-evaluation and seek the evaluation and comments of the supervisor.
