<sup>3</sup> Students must complete a total of 6 hours sequence in Biological Sciences or Physical Sciences. Acceptable Physical Sciences are Earth Science, Chemistry or Physics. Acceptable Biological Sciences are Zoology, Botany, Microbiology or General Biology. Certain combinations of Physical Sciences are not acceptable for degree credit.
