Southeastern Louisiana University Department of Mathematics Advanced Mathematics Placement Policies

Students admitted into Southeastern who have their official ACT scores entered into Southeastern's computer system are eligible for advanced math course placement and credit as indicated below:

- 1. A student whose math ACT subscore is 28 or above is eligible to enroll directly in MATH 162, 163, 175, or 241, depending upon their choice of major. Upon completion of MATH 162, 163, 175, or 241 with the grade of "C" or better in the first attempt, the student will receive the grade "P" in MATH 161, with 3 credit hours.
- A student whose math ACT subscore is 28 or above is eligible to enroll directly in MATH 200. Upon completion of MATH 200 with a grade of "C" or better in the first attempt, the student will receive the grade "P" in MATH 175, with 5 credit hours.
- 3. A student who earns credit in MATH 163, 200, or 241 via the AP, Cambridge International, or International Baccalaureate Calculus or Statistics exams will receive the grade of "P" in MATH 161, with 3 credit hours.
- 4. Students who transfer in a mathematics course at the level of trigonometry-based calculus or above with a grade of "C" or better will receive a grade of "P" for Math 161, with 3 credit hours.
