# Southeastern Louisiana University <br> Department of Mathematics <br> Mathematics Placement <br> via <br> Math ACT Scores 

Admitted students who have their official ACT scores entered into Southeastern's computer system are initially placed into their first mathematics courses as outlined below:

1. A student whose math ACT subscore is $\mathbf{1 8}$ or below is required to concurrently enroll in one of our corequisite courses, either MATH 100/105 or MATH 100/107.
2. Placement of beginning freshman according to their official math ACT subscore:

MATH 100: math ACT subscore of 18 or below (must be taken concurrently with either MATH 105 or MATH 107). Credit for MATH 100 does not count toward graduation.
MATH 105: math ACT subscore of 19 or higher.
MATH 107: math ACT subscore of 19 or higher.
MATH 161: math ACT subscore of 22 or higher.
MATH 175: math ACT subscore of 25 or higher.
MATH 200: math ACT subscore of 28 or higher.
