Synthesis Project: Each candidate for the DNP is required to complete a synthesis project in the student's area of interest, which incorporates DNP course work and represents an evidenced based intervention, evaluation and dissemination of findings. A student actively engaged in a synthesis project must be officially enrolled in NURS 809: Advanced Directed Study or a Residency course for credit.

The student is awarded a DNP degree and a Post-Masters' Certificate of Nursing practitioner to Psychiatric/Mental Health Nurse Practitioner upon completion of the program.
