Awards

1. One \$600.00 scholarship will be awarded.
2. Award will be based on academic merit, date of submission of completed application, essay submission, and residency as outlined below.
3. The award recipient will be notified during February of 2010.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Student must be enrolled at Southeastern at the time of application. Student must be an undergraduate with a minimum of 54 credit hours or a graduate student with a minimum of 9 hours or a graduate student with a minimum of 9 hours completed.
2. Student must return to Southeastern for at least one semester after participating in a Study Abroad program.
3. Student must have a minimum 3.00 cumulative GPA
4. Student must be a resident of the Florida Parishes: East Feliciana, West Feliciana, East Baton Rouge, St. Helena, Livingston, Tangipahoa, Washington, or St. Tammany. Students must submit a photocopy of their driver's license, utility bill, voter's registration, or other document establishing residency in one of these parishes.
5. Student must exemplify high moral character.
6. Students are required to turn in a short essay (no longer than one typewritten, double-spaced page) explaining why they want to study abroad.
7. Students must have been approved to participate in Study Abroad by the International Initiatives Office by December 12, 2009.

Note: Student is allowed to receive the award for one semester only and is not renewable.
