Awards:

- Up to \$2,775 to be awarded as follows:
 - \$500 awards to 3 undergraduate students
 - \$500 awards to 2 graduate students
 - \$275 award to 1 undergraduate
 - Each applicant must submit a short essay (no longer than one page) entitled "Why I Want to Study Abroad" and attach it to the application. Essays must be type written and double spaced.
 - Recipients will be selected by the IGDD Board of Directors on the basis of the criteria outlined here
 - Recipients will be notified by confirmation letter on or before February 1, 2007.

Applications:

- IGDD Study Abroad Scholarship applications are available at the International Initiatives Office, East Stadium, Room 102 or the on the IIO website.
- Completed IGDD Study Abroad Scholarship applications must be returned to the Interim Director of the International Initiatives office at East Stadium 102.
- **The Deadline to submit your completed IGDD Study Abroad Scholarship application is Friday, December 8.** Late applications will be accepted by the IGDD acting secretary, Charles A. Dranguet, Jr. depending on the availability of remaining scholarship funds. It is advised that you file your application as early as possible to maximize your chances of receiving an award.
- **VERY IMPORTANT: Before your application for an IGDD Study Abroad Scholarship can be considered for an award, you must first be approved to participate in Study Abroad by the International Initiatives Office (IIO). You must:**
 - a. Complete the Application to Participate in Study Abroad and submit it to the International Initiatives Office. The Application to Participate in Study Abroad is available in the IIO and at <http://www.selu.edu/Academics/studyabroad/>
 - b. Submit the \$100 Study Abroad Non-refundable deposit to the International Initiatives Office.
 - c. Submit two letters of recommendation to participate in Study Abroad to the International Initiatives Office.
 - d. **In order for the IIO to process your Application to Participate in Study Abroad in time to meet the IGDD deadline, steps a, b, and c must be completed by 4:00pm, December 1, 2007.**
 - e. After you have completed steps a, b, and c, the IIO will instruct you to meet with the appropriate Study Abroad Faculty Program Coordinator to complete a Course Approval and Recommendation to Participate Form.
 - f. After your interview with your Study Abroad Faculty Program Coordinator and completion of the Course Approval and Recommendation to Participate Form, the IIO will notify you and the IGDD Board of Directors of your approval or non-approval to participate in study abroad.

Requirements:

To be considered for an IGDD Study Abroad Scholarship, students must meet the following Requirements:

- Must be a continuing SLU student
- Undergraduates students must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA (at the end of Fall semester)
- Graduate students must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA (at the end of the Fall semester)
- Graduate students must be enrolled in Graduate School during the Fall 2006, Spring 2007 and Summer 2007 Semesters.
- Both GPA and hours taken during the Fall 2006 term will be considered in the final determination of awards.
- Students will be limited to no more than ONE IGDD Study Abroad Scholarship during their enrollment at Southeastern Louisiana University.
