1. Demonstration Lessons (Group or Individual)
2. Tutoring by college students
3. Diagnostic testing by college students or instructors
4. Videotaping for instructional purposes (student's or instructors) or faculty presentations
5. Participating in courses taught by methods students
6. Interviews/Questionnaires
7. Proving work samples for university instructional purposes
8. Audio-taping for instructional purposes
9. Participation in research approved by Southeastern Louisiana University CUHARS Committee
