Southeastern Louisiana University's *Northshore School of the Arts* is a professional, afternoon and evening program where committed junior and senior high school students have the opportunity to obtain university-level credit at Southeastern Louisiana University. Beyond the university credit, NSA students have an opportunity to prepare auditions and portfolios and add scholarly activities to their resume for scholarship applications. Students who are serious about the arts work with university faculty and other professional artists in their field. NSA is a program that challenges qualified students with advanced course work and state-of-the-art equipment and facilities. The nurturing of creative abilities will come to life in a unique way through the *Northshore School of the Arts*.

Pre-Registration Deadline: May 15, 2009 (This insures early acceptance and priority scheduling)

Admission:

- Admission to the *Northshore School of the Arts* is by audition for applied music classes; by interview for theatre classes; by portfolio review for studio art classes; and by a minimum of a 3.0 average in high school music/art classes for music theory and art history classes, respectively.

Application Procedure:

- Submit to the *Northshore School of the Arts*, Southeastern Louisiana University, SLU 10388, Hammond, LA 70402:
 - o A completed Application Form (attached, page 2)
 - o A \$20 application fee (check payable to NSA Southeastern)
 - o A copy of high school transcripts (if not available, a copy of high school report cards will suffice)
 - o For Studio Art Classes: 4 pieces of artwork, completed independently by the applicant: 2 representational drawings from life, and 2 creative or conceptual works in other media.

- Cost:**
- Through a collaborative agreement with the St. Tammany Parish Public School System, admitted St. Tammany public high school juniors and seniors pay the special rate of \$200 per class, plus a \$20 application fee. For the NSA Applied Music Classes ending with "2", the cost is \$400 plus a \$20 application fee. (see class listing, next page). Additional fees for textbook rentals (\$25 per book), and for art supplies may apply. For students who are taking two or more NSA courses, fees may be paid in two installments, with the first installment due by the date of the first class and the second due by September 23, 2009. Students who withdraw after the first day of class are not eligible for a refund, as instructors have been hired for the entire semester.

Music Auditions and Theatre Interviews:

- Theatre Interviews and Music Auditions for private/small group classes in piano, voice, string instruments, woodwind instruments, brass instruments, and percussion will be scheduled after pre-registration is complete. Applicants will be contacted for specific interview or audition date and location information. Note that Applied Music locations are determined by the instructor.

University Credit:

- Students who complete *Northshore School of the Arts* classes with a minimum of C-level work and meet any other academic departmental requirements for university course credit will be awarded credit with a grade of "P" (Pass) for articulated Southeastern Louisiana University courses upon enrollment at Southeastern. (Application to Southeastern is made separately, as is application for Music majors.)
