Turtle Cove Self-Guided Boardwalk Sign Sponsorships

The Turtle Cove Environmental Research Station, Southeastern's main field station, is accepting sponsorships for each of its 56 different wetland related signs. Ten of the signs are located on the first floor porch area and the main staircase at Turtle Cove and the Galva Canal Boat Shed in Manchac (designated as "premium sign locations") with the remaining 46 noted as "boardwalk sign locations."
