

Graduating Class Profile 2020-2021

Executive Summary

Each summer, the Office of Institutional Research prepares the Graduating Class Profile Report. This year's report contains information on the 2020-2021 graduates. Basic demographics are included as well as information on how long the graduates have attended Southeastern and from which institutions students last transferred.

During the 2020-2021 academic year Southeastern conferred a total of 2,190 awards, an increase of 54 (2.5%) awards from 2019-2020. Sixty-six percent (66%) of baccalaureate degree recipients are White, Non-Hispanic, while sixty-four percent (64%) are female.

Some highlights include:

- Twenty-four percent (24%) of the graduates classified as Beginning Freshmen graduated within four years. This is three percentage points lower from the 2019-2020 graduating class.
- For transfer students, Southeastern's leading feeder school is Baton Rouge Community College followed by Northshore Technical Community College, Louisiana State University, Delgado Community College, River Parishes Community College, University of Louisiana-Lafayette, Southern University-Baton Rouge, University of Louisiana-Monroe, Franciscan Missionaries of Our Lady, Pearl River Community College, and Southwest Mississippi Community College.
- The undergraduate baccalaureate program with the highest number of graduates in 2020-2021 is the B.G.S. General Studies. The B.S.N. Nursing, B.A. Management, B.S. Kinesiology, B.A. Marketing, and B.A. Psychology follow with the highest number of graduates.
- The baccalaureate programs (at least 5 graduates) with the highest percentage of students who began as transfers are: B.A. Sociology followed by B.G.S. General Studies, B.A. English, B.S. Information Technology, B.A. World Languages, B.A. Criminal Justice, and B.S. Sport Management. In contrast, the programs with the lowest percentage of transfers are B.S. Communication Sciences and Disorders, followed by B.A. Political Science, B.M. Music, B.S. Middle School Education, B.S. Biological Sciences, B.S. Health Education & Promotion, and B.S. Athletic Training.
- Seventy percent (70%) of the baccalaureate degree recipients started at Southeastern as Beginning Freshmen. This is up one percentage point over last year.
