

National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE) Results 2007-2008

Student Satisfaction

- 86% of students would attend Southeastern again if they started over.
- 89% of Southeastern students rate their educational experiences as good or excellent.
- 81% of Southeastern students say that other students are friendly and supportive, 78% think faculty are available and helpful, and 57% think administrators are helpful and considerate.

Institutional Commitment for Student Learning and Success

- 79% of students think Southeastern provides “quite a bit” of support for student success.
- 77% rate the quality of academic advising at Southeastern as good or excellent.
- 88% think Southeastern contributed “quite a bit” to their acquiring a broad general education and 73% think Southeastern contributed “quite a bit” to their acquiring job-related skills.

Student Interaction with Campus Faculty

- 62% of Southeastern students often discuss grades or assignments with an instructor.
- 47% of students often talk about career plans with a faculty member.
- 63% often work harder than they thought they could to meet faculty’s expectations.

Active Learning Experiences

- 65% of Southeastern students plan on participating in or have participated in community service or volunteer work.
- 74% of Southeastern students plan on participating in or have participated in some type of hands-on experience (internship, practicum, clinical assignment, etc.).
- 62% of Southeastern students often participate in class discussions.
