

Over 225 students participated in Undergraduate Research during 2008 - 2009. Some highlights of the research include:

- » Seventy-one students were presenters or co-presenters at state, regional, national, and international conferences including:
  - Southeast Athletic Trainers' Association Student Symposium
  - 42<sup>nd</sup> Annual Convention of the Association for Behavioral & Cognitive Therapy
  - Southeastern Journalism Conference
- » Ten students were coauthors on papers, including the Journal of Nursing Education.
- » Ninety-three students competed in regional competitions/publications or were invited performers, including the American College Dance Festival and the Regional Convention of the National Association of Teachers of Singing.
