### 2011 - 2012 Highlights

- » The Office of International Initiatives works to increase the global vision of the students of Southeastern Louisiana University by providing participants with cross-cultural and international experiences essential to success in a global economy and to strengthen the educational, economic, and social relations between the United States and other countries. The office accomplishes this goal using a two-pronged approach offering Study Abroad programs

- » led and taught by Southeastern faculty members and joining with partner institutions across the globe to provide opportunities for student and faculty exchanges.
- » A total of ten Study Abroad programs were offered in 2012 with 174 students and 14 faculty participating in a total of 58 courses.
- » The Student Government Association continued its support for Study Abroad by generously providing \$40,000 in scholarships, awarding 40 students \$1,000 each. Additional scholarships were awarded by the Institute for Global and Domestic Development, the Charles Redman Endowment, the Department of Foreign Languages and Communication, and the Southeastern Louisiana University Spanish Club.
- » In addition to the Study Abroad opportunities, several students took advantage of the cooperative agreements between Southeastern Louisiana University and other universities world-wide to spend a semester or an entire year studying at a foreign institution.
