

National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE) Results 2013-2014



Student Satisfaction

- » 87% of students would attend Southeastern again if they started over.
- » 88% of Southeastern students rate their educational experiences as good or excellent.
- » On a scale from 1 to 7, students on average rated their interactions with students a 5.6, interactions with faculty a 5.5 and interactions with academic advisors a 5.3.

Institutional Commitment to Student Learning and Success

- » 71% of students think Southeastern provides “quite a bit” of support to help students succeed academically.
- » 64% of the students think Southeastern provides “quite a bit” of support for their overall well-being.
- » 81% of seniors think Southeastern contributed “quite a bit” or more to their critical and analytical thinking and 75% think Southeastern contributed “quite a bit” or more to their ability to write clearly and effectively.

Student Interaction with Campus Faculty

- » 80% of Southeastern students discuss their academic performance with a faculty member.
- » 83% of students talk about career plans with a faculty member.
- » 71% discuss course topics, ideas, or concepts with a faculty member outside of class.

Active Learning Experiences

- » 59% of Southeastern seniors had at least some courses that included a community based project.
- » 72% of Southeastern students plan on participating in or have participated in some type of hands-on experience (internship, practicum, clinical assignment, etc.).
- » 63% of Southeastern students often asked questions or contributed to course discussions in other ways.
