Reminder about your Grant Purchases

This past spring, the requirement that purchase requisitions over \$500 must be approved by the Office of Sponsored Research and Programs was adjusted to purchase requisitions over \$1,000. This will provide consistency with the procurement card (p card) purchase limit of \$1,000.

Don't forget that as budget unit head, you are required to provide OSRP with a copy of ALL purchase requisitions and p-card itemized logs no matter the amount spent. It is suggested that these be submitted to OSRP monthly.
