RE: Summary of Police Reports for the week of January 6 to 12, 2008.

Sunday, January 6

0152 hours. LRS 32:863.3 Vehicle Not Insured. A non-student was driving on University Avenue without a license plate. When stopped, the driver also could not provide proof of insurance coverage. The vehicle was towed and a family member drove the subject from the scene.

Monday, January 7

Tuesday, January 8

1053 hours. Auto Crash. A non-student was backing from a parking space on SGA Drive and struck a vehicle that was stopped on the roadway. No injuries were reported at the scene.

1307 hours. LRS 14:62 Simple Burglary. An employee reported several tools were missing from a secured area at the Physical Plant. The incident is under investigation.

Wednesday, January 9

1632 hours. Code of Conduct Violation. A student was seen tampering with the control arm at the entrance to Southeastern Oaks. The student was located and referred to Judicial Affairs.

Thursday, January 10

2243 hours. LRS 32:123 Disobeyed Stop Sign; LRS 32:415 Suspended Driver's License. A student was driving on North General Pershing Street and was issued a citation for disobeying a stop sign at Texas Avenue and driving with a suspended driver's license.

Friday, January 11

0236 hours. LRS 32:361.1 Cracked Windshield; LRS 32:415 Suspended Driver's License; LRS 14:98 Driving While Intoxicated; LRS 14:108 Resisting an Officer. A subject was driving on University Avenue with a cracked windshield and swerved out of his travel lane twice. When stopped, the driver, later identified as a student, smelled of an alcoholic beverage, stumbled when he attempted to walk, and his speech was impaired. When given the opportunity for a standardized field sobriety test, the student refused and began to physically resist the officers. The student was placed under arrest and refused the opportunity for a test for chemical intoxication. The student, who also had a suspended driver's license, was booked into the Hammond City Jail and referred to Judicial Affairs.

2329 hours. LRS 40:966 Possession of Marijuana; LRS 40:967 Possession of Schedule II Narcotic; LRS 40:1023 Possession of Drug Paraphernalia; LRS 32:300 Open Container. A non-student was driving on North Pine Street Extension and was stopped for failure to signal a turn. The driver was found to be in possession of two baggies containing suspected marijuana and a single suspected ecstasy pill. There were also two open containers of alcoholic beverage in the vehicle. The driver was arrested and booked into the Tangipahoa Parish Jail for the drugs and paraphernalia and a passenger was cited for the open container.

Saturday, January 12

0346 hours. LRS 14:103 Disturbing the Peace (Public Intoxication); Code of Conduct Violation. A student was found near the Sims Library in a state of serious intoxication. The student had vomited and struck his face. The student was transported to North Oaks Hospital via Acadian Ambulance, issued a misdemeanor summons, and referred to Judicial Affairs.

1648 hours. LRS 14:65.1 Purse Snatching. A non-student reported being approached by three unidentified subjects near McGehee Hall. One of the subjects grabbed her purse, pulling it from her grasp, and all three subjects fled the scene. No injuries or weapons were reported. The incident is under investigation.

Between 1415 hours and 1720 hours. LRS 14:62 Burglary (Vehicle). A student reported parking her vehicle near Livingston Hall and when she returned, the vehicle contents were strewn about the vehicle. No items were reported missing and the incident is under investigation.

Between 1400 hours and 1740 hours. LRS 14:62 Burglary (Vehicle). An employee reported parking her vehicle near D Vickers Hall and when she returned, the vehicle contents were strewn about the vehicle and a checkbook was missing. The incident is under investigation.
