Educational Foundations

EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATIONS (EDF)

- 600. Educational Research. Credit 3 hours. Principles and procedures in the scientific study of educational problems. Examination of principal research methods and application of research principles.
- 607. Philosophy of Education. Credit 3 hours. A study of major philosophical systems and the educational theories associated with each system.
- 615. History of Education. Credit 3 hours. The growth and development of education and educational institutions from prehistoric times to the seventeenth century.
- 616. History of American Education. Credit 3 hours. The development of American education from the seventeenth to the twentieth century.
- 673. Independent Study. Credit 3 hours. Prerequisites: Educational Foundations 600 and permission of the Department Head. Student completes research study and report under direction of graduate instructor. The course may be repeated for a total of 6 hours, with no more than 3 credit hours in any one semester. A maximum of 3 hours of credit in Independent Study may be applied toward the Master of Education Degree and a maximum of 6 hours may be applied toward the Specialist in Education degree.
- 674. Readings in Education. Credit 3 hours. Prerequisites: Educational Foundations 600 and permission of the Department Head. Directed readings on selected topics in education. Area(s) of reading and study to be designated by instructor. Student may repeat the course for a total of 6 credit hours, with no more than 3 credit hours in any one semester. A maximum of 3 hours of credit in Readings may be applied toward the Master of Education degree and a maximum of 6 hours may be applied toward the Specialist in Education degree.
- 701. Educational Statistics. Credit 3 hours. Prerequisite: Educational Foundations 600. Study of basic statistical concepts, both descriptive and inferential. Emphasis is placed on the use of these concepts in solving educational problems.
- 713. Independent Research Study. Credit 3 hours. Prerequisite: Educational Foundations 600 and advanced standing in the Specialist program. Examination and in-depth study, research, and evaluation of contemporary problems.

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
