- c) successfully complete the English Department's computer literacy test.

NOTE: Students choosing option 2 must also complete a three-hour free elective.

³Students must complete a minimum of 6 hours plus requisite laboratory courses in a two-semester sequence of a biological science plus a physical science and the requisite laboratory (excluding Chemistry 106) or a two-semester sequence of a physical science (excluding Chemistry 106) plus a biological science and the requisite laboratory.

⁴Students may elect a course in Anthropology, Economics, Geography, Political Science, Psychology, or Sociology, excluding Geography 205.

⁵At least 12 hours of general electives must be 300- or 400-level courses.
