

SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNSELING (SAC)

619. Substance Abuse Counseling. Credit 3 hours. Prerequisites: HD 601, CED 603 and CED 605. This course will provide a general knowledge base concerning the emotional, social, physical and spiritual impact of addiction upon the abuser and the family system. Special emphasis will be given to the principles of the progression of addiction, treatment modalities, recovery and relapse prevention. (Summer, Spring)

631. Addiction Principles and Treatments. Credit 3 hours. Prerequisites: HD 601, CED 603, CED 605, SAC 619. This course examines professional principles and practices of addiction counseling. The nature of addictions, diagnosis, treatments, and advanced counseling interventions will be addressed. (Spring)
