U. S. real gross domestic product grew at a 2.0 percent annual rate during the second quarter of 2019. Year-over-year, 2Q2019 real GDP was 2.8 percent higher than in the second quarter of 2018.

Total civilian employment for the second quarter of 2019 rose 0.9 percent compared to the second quarter of 2018, while the labor force grew by 0.6 percent. This led to a decline in the unemployment rate from 3.9 percent in 2Q2018 to 3.6 percent in 2Q2019.

A survey of professional forecasters released in August 2019 by the Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia projects U.S. Real GDP to grow by 2.3, 1.9, 2.0, and 2.1 percent in 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022, respectively.

While the 2021 forecast was 0.1 percent higher than in the group's May survey, the other three years were down 0.1 to 0.3 percent.

Total state employment for the second quarter of 2019 increased 0.3 percent from the previous quarter and 0.2 percent compared to 2Q2018.

The statewide labor force for 2Q2019 decreased by 0.2 percent from the previous quarter and 0.4 percent compared to 2Q2018.

The unemployment rate decreased from 5.0 percent in 2Q2018 to 4.4 percent in 2Q2019.

Initial unemployment insurance claims in 2Q2019 were down 7.5 percent compared to 2Q2018, and continuing claims were down 12.0 percent.

Estimated statewide taxable retail sales (not including motor vehicles) in 2Q2019 increased by 1.6 percent compared to 2Q2018.

Seasonally-adjusted state personal income in 1Q0219 increased 1.2 percent from the previous quarter and 4.8 percent compared to 1Q2018. Year-over-year, net earnings rose 4.5 percent,

dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.9 percent, and personal transfer receipts rose by 6.1 percent.

Industries contributing the most year-over-year growth in earnings from 1Q2018 to 1Q2019 were Health care and social assistance (+\$2.4 billion) Mining (+491 million), and State & local government (+\$488 million).

The only industries with year-over-year declines in earnings were *Arts, entertainment, & recreation* (-\$17 million) and *Finance & insurance* (-\$10 million).

On a percentage basis the largest gainers were Health care & social assistance (+14.8 percent), Farm earnings (+11.9 percent), and Forestry, fishing, & related activities (+10.4 percent), with Arts, entertainment, & recreation and Finance & insurance down 1.1 and 0.2 percent, respectively.



Northshore Employment

Total employment among Northshore residents in 2Q2019 was up 0.9 percent both from the prior quarter and compared to 2Q2018.

The total Northshore civilian work force in 2Q2019 was up 0.8 percent over the prior quarter and 0.1 percent compared to 2Q2018.

With employment up by a much larger percentage year-over-year than the labor force, the Northshore unemployment rate dropped from 4.8 percent in 2Q2018 to 4.1 percent in 2Q2019.




Northshore Estimated Retail Sales

Northshore retail sales for 2Q2019 averaged \$823 million per month, an increase of 1.1 percent compared to 2Q2018. Sales were down 1.7 percent in Livingston Parish and increased in the other four parishes - ranging from 1.7 percent in

Tangipahoa and St. Tammany parishes to 8.7 percent in St. Helena.

(Note: St. Helena's collections may have been increased by audit findings related to prior quarters.)




Northshore Residential Building Permits

The number of residential building permits issued in the Northshore region during 2Q2019 (excluding St. Helena Parish—for which data were not available) was down 15.9 percent compared to the second quarter of 2018, and the number of permitted units was down 34.8 percent.

Year-over-year permitted unit counts were up 126.7 percent in Washington Parish but down in the other three parishes — ranging from –9.7 percent in Livingston to –62.8 percent in Tangipahoa.




Northshore Residential Home Sales


There were 2,327 Northshore homes sold during 2Q2019 at an average price of \$229,089. The

number sold and the average price were up 4.3 and 2.0 percent, respectively, over 2Q2018.

Livingston Parish

The number of employed Livingston Parish residents fell by 0.1 percent from 2Q2018 to 2Q2019, while the civilian labor force dropped by 0.6 percent.


This resulted in a decline in the unemployment rate from 4.2 percent of 2Q2018 to 3.7 percent in 2Q2019.


The value of taxable retail sales in 2Q2019 averaged \$158.0 million per month, down 1.7 percent from 2Q2018.

The number of residential building permits issued in 2Q2019 was down 9.7 percent compared to the second quarter of 2018.

The number of homes sold in 2Q2019 was up 11.7 percent compared to 2Q2018, and the average price increased 11.1 percent to \$202,683, resulting in total residential sales volume increasing by 24.2 percent.

Livingston Parish residents purchased 1,540 new cars and light trucks in 2Q2019, up 10.2 percent from 1,397 in 2Q2018.



St. Helena Parish

Employment among St. Helena Parish residents in the second quarter of 2019 was down 0.2 percent from 2Q2018. The labor force contracted by a much larger 1.6 percent, leading to a decrease in the unemployment rate from 6.8 percent in 2Q2018 to 5.5 percent in 2Q2019.

Sales tax collections within St. Helena Parish in the second quarter of 2019 (including some audit assessments) increased 8.7 percent compared to 2Q2018.

Building permit data were not available for St. Helena Parish for 2Q2019.

There were five homes sold in St. Helena Parish in 2Q2019 at an average price of \$247,000. The number sold was up 25 percent from four in 2Q2018, while the average price was up 285.2 percent.

St. Helena Parish residents purchased 48 new cars and light trucks in 2Q2019, down 31.4 percent from 70 in 2Q2018.





St. Tammany Parish

The number of employed St. Tammany Parish residents increased by 1.6 percent from 2Q2018 to 2Q2019, while the civilian labor force increased by a smaller 0.9 percent. This led to a decline in the unemployment rate from 4.4 percent in 2Q2018 to 3.7 percent in 2Q2019.


The value of taxable retail sales in St. Tammany Parish averaged \$423.3 million per month in 2Q2019, an increase of 1.7 percent over the second quarter of 2018.


The number of building permits issued for residential units in 2Q2019 decreased by 13.4 per-

cent compared to the second quarter of 2018.

The number of homes sold in St. Tammany Parish in 2Q2019 was down 0.4 percent compared to 2Q2018 but the average selling price increased by 1.7 percent, leading to a 1.2 percent increase in total residential sales volume.

St. Tammany Parish residents purchased 3,423 cars and light trucks in 2Q2019, up 2.9 percent from 3,325 in 2Q2018. Approximately 55.0 percent of purchases in 2Q2019 were from dealers within St. Tammany Parish.





Tangipahoa Parish

The number of employed Tangipahoa Parish residents rose by 0.5 percent from 2Q2018 to 2Q2019, while the civilian labor force declined by 0.4 percent, causing the unemployment rate to fall from 5.7 percent in 2Q2018 to 4.9 percent in 2Q2019.


The value of taxable retail sales in 2Q2019 averaged \$192.8 million per month, an increase of 1.7 percent compared to 2Q2018.


The number of residential construction units permitted in 2Q2019 was down 126.7 percent compared to 2Q2018, which was inordinately high due





Washington Parish

The number of employed Washington Parish residents in the second quarter of 2019 increased by 0.9 percent compared to 2Q2018.

The labor force increased by a smaller 0.2 percent, resulting in a decrease in the unemployment rate from 6.1 percent in 2Q2018 to 5.4 percent in 2Q2019.

Taxed retail sales in Washington Parish averaged \$42.4 million in 2Q2019, an increase of 2.0 percent over 2Q2018.

2Q2019, up 126.7 percent from 15 in 2Q2018.



Southeastern Nursing awarded \$2.4 million Workforce Grant

Southeastern Louisiana University has received a \$2.45 million Workforce Opportunity for Rural Communities grant from the U.S. Department of Labor. Awarded to the College of Nursing and Health Sciences' Rural Nurses Career Advancement Program (RN-CAP), in coordination with the Delta Regional Authority, the grant is part of an investment to expand the impact of workforce development efforts across the Mississippi River Delta.

Southeastern's RN-CAP program is designed to enhance community-based primary care in the rural, underserved Delta region of southeastern Louisiana that includes Livingston, St. Helena, St. James, Tangipahoa and Washington parishes.

"A healthy workforce is a productive workforce," Louisiana Economic Development Secretary Don Pierson said. "With thousands of primary care providers needed to meet the current medical needs of rural America, this nursing initiative by Southeastern will provide a pathway to better health care for our workers and for their children and older relatives who deserve the best care we can provide. We appreciate the support of DRA and the Department of Labor in accelerating technology and training solutions for this critical priority."

The program also creates and provides innovative workforce development credentialing in telehealth and data in healthcare, two critical areas in rural healthcare workforce development needs.

Southeastern is collaborating with North Oaks Health System and Northshore Technical Community College in this endeavor.

To help fill the workforce demands in the region and provide residents with viable career training, Southeastern and NTCC have partnered on an innovative reverse transfer program wherein four-year students may enter an accelerated LPN program at NTCC and then immediately enter into a fast-track BSN pathway at Southeastern.
